### Nevada Behaviorally Complex Care Program

The Nevada Behaviorally Complex Care Program (BCCP) provides specialized services for individuals with complex behavioral health needs, including mental health, substance abuse, and co-occurring disorders. BCCP provides funding for coordinated support through comprehensive assessments, personalized treatment plans, multidisciplinary care teams including higher levels of staffing, and training. The BCCP program helps ensure access to long-term placement in nursing facilities with a focus on improving outcomes and quality of life and aims to address individual needs.

The analysis includes data from nine Nevada facilities actively engaged in the state-funded behavioral program, spanning from November '22 to October '23.



# **Behavioral Health**

A significant number of individuals in nursing facilities had at least one behavioral health diagnosis, indicating the widespread prevalence of such conditions among facility residents. These findings emphasize the urgent need for tailored interventions and support services to address the complex challenges faced by individuals with behavioral health diagnoses.

# **Emergency Room Utilization**

The impact study revealed significant findings regarding emergency room (ER) visits. In comparing the non-BCCP population, where 9.5% of individuals were transferred to an ER for care, to the BCCP population, which showed a notably lower rate of 2.7%, it is evident that BCCP, in conjunction with BHS, effectively manages behavioral health (BH) issues within the facility rather than resorting to the emergency department. This represents a substantial decrease in ER admissions, showcasing the effectiveness of the collaborative approach among individuals with behavioral health diagnoses and its potential to enhance patient outcomes and reduce healthcare costs.

#### **Impact Study**

Behavioral Health Solutions commenced an impact study in collaboration with 3x Advisors, an independent consulting firm, focusing on BCCP participants in Nevada nursing facilities. The objective is to showcase the efficacy of state funding programs when combined with behavioral health supportive services. Preliminary findings highlight a positive influence on individual patient well-being, along with a significant and favorable economic impact on the financial landscape of the healthcare system.
